The Bible says that sin is anything you "think, say or do" that breaks God's Law. Sin is when you disobey God. Romans 3:23 tells us:

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"

Just like when you disobey your parents, when you disobey God there is a punishment. This is because God is perfect (Holy) and fair (Just) so He can not accept sin and justice requires a punishment for the sin. The Bible describes the punishment for disobeying God in Romans 6:23

"For the wages of sin is death..."

Really bad news for all of us, but God has a loving plan to save us as we will talk about in the next few colors.

Earlier we talked about how justice demands a punishment for our sin, but God is also perfectly Loving. God knows that you can not save yourself so God loved us so much that He sent His only Son Jesus to die on the cross to pay for our sins. Jesus lived a perfect life and then took our punishment so that all our sins may be washed away (purified). 1 John 1:7 says it this way:

"the blood of Jesus, His Son purifies us from all sin"

We talked about how God is loving and sent His Son Jesus to die on the cross to pay for our sins. That is the greatest gift we can ever receive because along with forgiveness comes eternal life with Him in Heaven.

There is one thing that you need to do, accept God's gift by faith. The Bible says in Ephesians 2:8-9:

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast"

If you don't accept God's gift of forgiveness through \underline{faith} in \underline{Jesus} it is like leaving the best Christmas gift ever under the tree unopened forever - and it will do you \underline{no} good. Accepting the gift is as easy as A-B-C A-Admit you sin

We have talked about how you accept God's loving gift by faith. This color and the following two, we will talk more about the gift God has given us.

The first thing that happens as soon as you accept God's gift of salvation is that you are forgiven of every sin. You are completely cleansed from all sin as it says in Isaiah 1:18

"Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool."

Just like you could do nothing to save yourself, if you accept God's gift of forgiveness you can do nothing to lose your forgiveness since it is all based on Jesus' payment of our sin.

Your sins are washed clean and you are forever forgiven by God.

Christians want to grow closer to God because of the great and loving gift God has given us. Growing closer to God will give us peace and joy in our lives.

"In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you

Jesus is telling us that He is preparing a place in Heaven for everyone who <u>accepts</u> His gift of salvation. Jesus continues to tell us in John 14:3

"And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am."

So Jesus will take everyone who accepts His gift of salvation to Heaven where we will live forever with Him.
